

RESOLUTION OF AUTHORIZATION

THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION OF ARIZONA

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 23-1041(E) directs the Industrial Commission of Arizona (“Commission”) to adopt, not later than August 1 of each calendar year, an amount that shall be the maximum average monthly wage under A.R.S. § 23-1041(D)(8) for the next calendar year.

WHEREAS, A.R.S. § 23-1041(E) directs the Commission to adopt an amount that adjusts the amount from the prior year to reflect the annual percentage increase in the Bureau of Labor Statistics, *Employment Cost Index* for the prior calendar year. In applying the Bureau of Labor Statistics, *Employment Cost Index*, A.A.C. R20-5-165 mandates that the Commission use the specific index titled: *Employment Cost Index for Wages and Salaries, for Civilian Workers, by Occupational Group and Industry, All Workers*.

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Labor Statistics, *Employment Cost Index for Wages and Salaries, for Civilian Workers, by Occupational Group and Industry, All Workers*, reflects a percentage increase of 3.1% for the twelve months ending in December 2018, which results in a \$146.99 increase to the maximum average monthly wage (from \$4,741.57 to \$4,888.56).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION OF ARIZONA, in exercise of the foregoing authority, the Commission adopts the amount of **\$4,888.56** for the amount under A.R.S. § 23-1041(D)(8) for injuries that occur during calendar year 2020.
