Ms. Dimas confirmed Commission meeting dates through February 2021.

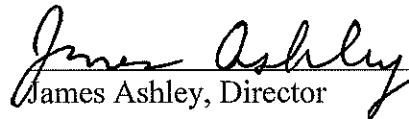
Public Comment.
