



Governor's Executive Budget Proposal Includes Funding to Implement the ICA's Fraud Unit.

Phoenix, AZ — Today Governor Hobbs released her FY2026 Executive Budget, which funds critical programs and efforts protecting Arizona's workforce.

The Executive Budget includes an increase in funding for ten full-time employees (FTEs) to establish the agency's Fraud Unit. The ICA was directed, by statute, to establish a Fraud Unit to investigate fraudulent activities, statements, or representations made in connection with workers' compensation claims.

Arizona continues to experience record-setting growth and attract new businesses. As we welcome new opportunities and industries to our vibrant state, safeguarding our workforce becomes not just a necessity, but a cornerstone of maintaining Arizona's status as an economic leader in the Southwest..
