



Revised and Modernized Employer's Report of Injury Form Available Now

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Phoenix, AZ – July 28, 2025 – The ICA Claims Division has successfully launched a modernization of the Employer's Report of Injury. ARS§ 23-908(G) and 23-1061(E) require the Employer to notify the carrier & the commission within 10 days on the form and in the manner as prescribed by the commission. This initiative has been a significant undertaking by the Claims Division, MIS teams, and ICA's developers and was developed in conjunction with stakeholders.

The 101 - Employer's Report of Injury (101) has been modernized as described:

- Streamlined by almost 50% fewer questions.
 - The form revision has eliminated duplicate questions that are required on other occupational injury forms and also simplified the information required of the employer.
- Available only electronically as a webform on the ICA Claims [Employers website](#).

Although the modified form is now available, employers may continue to use the existing version of the form until August 30, 2025, at which time usage of the webform forms will become mandatory. Effective August 30, 2025, existing versions of the 101 will no longer be authorized for use, and all previously authorized alterations of the forms will expire.
