## **Minimum Wage Increase - January 1, 2021**

Phoenix, AZ, 09-17-2020

In accordance with A.R.S. § 23-363(B), the Industrial Commission of Arizona has adopted a resolution increasing the minimum wage from \$12.00 to \$12.15. The increase in minimum wage, which is effective January 1, 2021, was determined by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics' [Consumer Price Index](#) and is consistent with the increase in the cost of living.
