Notice of 2020-2021 Physicians' and Pharmaceutical Fee Schedule
Supplemental Public Hearing

On **August 17, 2020**, the Industrial Commission of Arizona will hold a **supplemental** Fee Schedule Public Hearing pertaining to the annual review of the Physicians' and Pharmaceutical Fee Schedule. See A.R.S. § 23-908(B). The supplemental public hearing will begin at 1:00 p.m. **and will be conducted telephonically**. A stakeholder or member of the public wishing to make a comment during the hearing is asked to send their name and the organization they represent, if applicable, to Kara Dimas by e-mail (Kara.Dimas@azica.gov) in advance of the meeting.

In addition to public comments, the Commission will also consider an **amended** proposal prepared by Commission staff, which is currently posted on the Commission's MRO webpage (<https://www.azica.gov/divisions/medical-resource-office-mro>). The Amended Staff Proposal is a preliminary document that is intended to serve as a foundational document for discussions that may arise during the supplemental public hearing. The Amended Staff Proposal contains revisions based on public comments received by the Commission in response to the Staff Proposal posted on May 22, 2020.

The record is considered open, and written and oral comments will be accepted until close of business on August 17, 2020.
