Dear Stakeholder,

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) is requesting stakeholder input on the effectiveness of engineering and work practice control methods not currently included for the tasks and equipment listed on [Table 1 of Respirable Crystalline Silica](#) standard for construction.

OSHA is also requesting information on tasks and equipment involving exposure to respirable crystalline silica that are not currently listed on Table 1, along with information on the effectiveness of engineering and work practice control methods in limiting worker exposure to respirable crystalline silica when performing those tasks. OSHA will use the information received in response to this request to determine what action, if any, it may take to reduce regulatory burdens and create jobs while improving worker safety.
