I am writing in support of the proposed legislation on "Payment to treating providers who participate in healthcare, preferred provider organization, outcome based network, or specialty networks". These "middlemen" do not improve care for the injured worker and limit access to qualified providers. They increase administrative costs and encourage volume based clinics due to poor reimbursement, thus, contributing to poorer overall care. The steep discounts they insist clinics accept is unreasonable and only seems to benefit the network itself. It's in the best interests of the patient and their employer to have access to qualified providers who do not participate in these "networks".
