

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, A.R.S. § 23-1041(E) directs the Industrial Commission of Arizona ("Commission") to adopt, not later than August 1 of each calendar year, beginning August 1, 2009, an amount that shall be the maximum average monthly wage under A.R.S. § 23-1041(D)(8) for the following calendar year.

**WHEREAS**, A.R.S. § 23-1041(E) directs the Commission to adopt an amount that adjusts the amount from the prior year to reflect the annual percentage increase in the Bureau of Labor Statistics, *Employment Cost Index* for the prior calendar year. In applying the Bureau of Labor Statistics, *Employment Cost Index*, the Commission has selected a specific index and that index is the *Employment Cost Index for Wages and Salaries, for Civilian Workers, by Occupational Group and Industry, All Workers*.

**WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Labor Statistics, *Employment Cost Index for Wages and Salaries, for Civilian Workers, by Occupational Group and Industry, All Workers*, increased 1.7 comparing December 2012 to December 2011, which increases the 2013 average monthly wage of \$4,185.78 by \$71.16 to \$4,256.94.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION OF ARIZONA**, in exercise of the foregoing authority, the Commission adopts the amount of \$4,256.94 for the amount under A.R.S. § 23-1041(D)(8) for injuries that occur during calendar year 2014.






